TRAINING OVERVIEW

The REACH regulation entered into force on the first of June 2007, making it essential that all manufacturers, importers, distributors and downstream users of chemicals be prepared and fully aware of the vast impact that REACH has on their business and relations with their suppliers.

Compliance with REACH starts with understanding your role and responsibilities within the framework of the regulation and developing a strategy towards adapting to it. To assist you with these first critical steps, SGS has put together a series of introductory day-long REACH training sessions. TRAINING OBJECTIVES

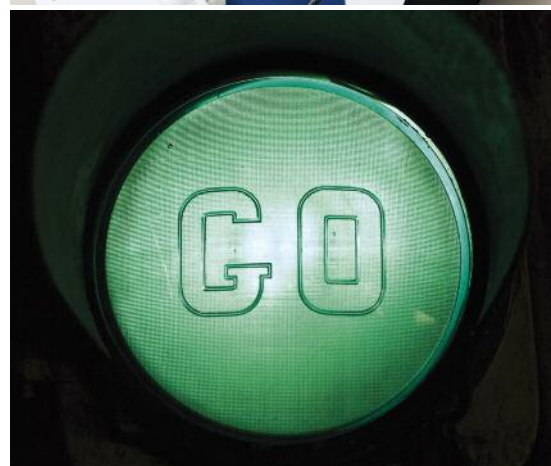
- Learn how to make an initial assessment of the implications of REACH throughout the whole supply chain.

- Understand the responsibility of those supplying articles, in particular regarding those working with Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC).
- Understand the responsibility of communication through the supply chain.

This software makes it easier to identify the participants' roles and obligations under REACH in a step-by-step approach and to find the relevant information quickly and easily. It allows a quick check of substances listed under REACH, substances exempted from registration, restricted substances and SVHC. 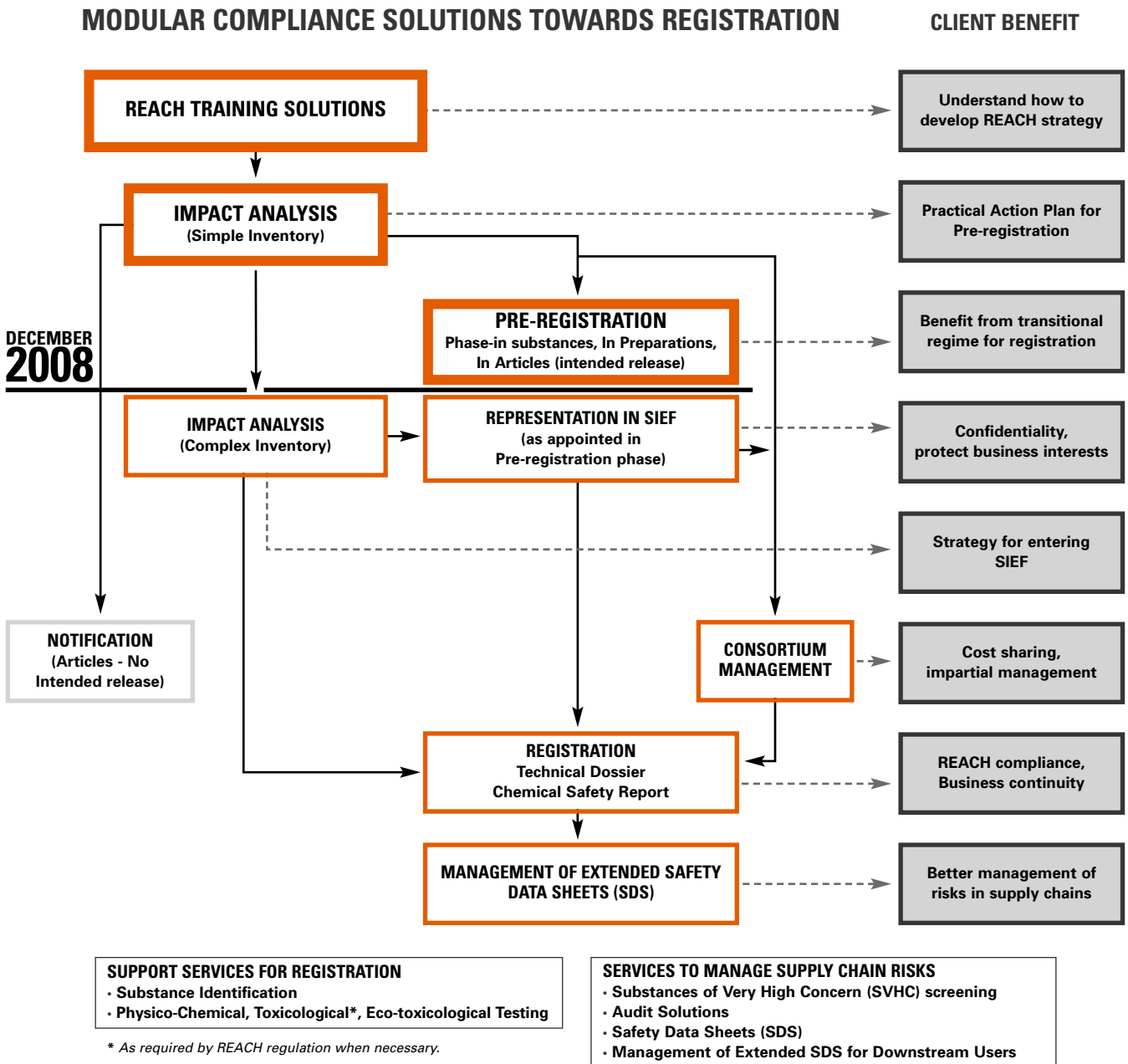
